## GEOLOGY OF UNAWEEP CANYON AND GATEWAY AREA

**Cost** - None (donations to the Chenoweth Fund are encouraged). **Food** - None provided; bring your own lunch, snacks, water, etc.


**Liability** - Participants will need to sign a liability waiver before participating.
