In February, 2018, Sunset Mesa Funeral Directors in Montrose, CO, was raided by the FBI. The business was suspected of selling bodies and body parts without permission and substituting cement or other substances for the missing cremation remains (cremains). The FBI received numerous requests to clarify whether cremains were bone or something else and the FBI in turn asked the CMU Forensic Anthropology Program for assistance. Melissa Connor, head of that program, in turn asked the Geology Program's X-ray lab to help with the project. This talk will review the work that the X-ray lab did to confirm the presence of bone in the cremains and to identify contamination when present.
